

Dear Parents:

Plans are well underway for the Junior Senior Banquet (“JSB”) on April 20, 2018. The Junior class hosts the Seniors for this event and the Junior parents are hosting the After Banquet Party (“ABP”).

WHEN: Friday, April 20, 2018

WHO: PCHS Juniors and Seniors and their guests

WHERE: Dinner, dance and entertainment at the PCHS Gym
After Banquet Party at the Vermeer Pavilion

COST: Complimentary Dinner courtesy of the junior class for all PCHS Juniors and Seniors
(PC Juniors and Seniors will have to pay \$10 for dinner if they register after the deadline)
\$10 per guest for the Junior Senior Banquet: dinner (**ONLY** for **NON** PC juniors or seniors)
\$10 per person for the After Banquet Party (**ALL attending the ABP must pay this fee**)

**Parents are requested to be present only during the open house, student arrival and scheduled volunteer shifts.*

The junior parents have been working to raise funds for the ABP and have contacted area businesses for donations of cash and prizes. The PC Booster Club has also donated funds towards the AFP Party. The remainder of the expense for the After Party will be collected through the \$10 entrance fee per student/guest. This fee covers their admission to the After Banquet Party and enters them into prize drawings.

Our goal is to have a fun, safe, engaging ABP for our students. Having enough parent volunteers is crucial to that success, so we are asking that at **least one parent of each junior student** (and any senior parents who desire) volunteer to work at least one shift at the After Banquet Party (ABP). There are a variety of jobs you could be asked to help with (checking students in/out, supervising games, helping with prizes or food.) Parents are asked to park at the far north end of the Pavilion parking lot and enter and exit through the west doors.

JUNIOR/SENIOR BANQUET DRESS CODE

Girls:

- Dresses need to be at least knee length with no slits higher than knee length*
- The top of the dress may not show any cleavage when standing up or bending forward.*
- The back of dresses may not come below 1 inch under the shoulder blades*
- Dresses may not have any holes or see through areas that show any cleavage, stomach, lower back or any part of the leg above the knee.*
- Lace up dresses: the laces must come together with no gaps or there must be a privacy panel to cover up the back.*

Guys:

- May wear a suit*
- May wear nice dress pants (no jeans with holes, sweat pants/athletic pants or shorts)*
- May wear a button down or polo shirt. No t-shirts or jerseys.*
- May not wear caps but top hat and other dress hats are allowed.*

AFTER BANQUET PARTY DRESS CODE

- Shirts and/or dresses must have a sleeve of some form and must be long enough to be tucked in. No skin may be showing while standing or seated – either bare back or bare midriff. The neckline is to be no lower than 1 inch below the collarbone and no cleavage shown at any time.*
- Sweatshirts and T-shirts are permitted that promote PCHS school spirit, favorite sports, teams and/or sportswear, favorite colleges or universities, Christian camps and activities. Not permitted is clothing with logos or wording that promote alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, secular rock groups, or is suggestive of a non-Christian attitude or behavior.*
- No visible body piercings (except ears) or visible tattoos.*
