School History & Purpose

Pella Christian was established in 1939 as a private Christian high school located in South Central Iowa. We are governed by a board of elected constituents and accredited by the Iowa State Board of Education. Therefore we are partners with parents and local churches in educating the young people in our communities.

Curriculum

Pella Christian provides a liberal arts education including rigorous college prep courses as well as courses in industrial arts, fine arts, and family and consumer sciences. Students have the opportunity to receive college credit for various courses through dual enrollment and/or online course agreements with Des Moines Area Community College. Limited AP courses are available.

Schedule Structure

Pella Christian utilizes an 8 period/day class schedule. Chapel is held on Tuesday and Friday. Intramurals take place on Mondays and an MTSS study period is held every Thursday for 25 minutes.
