

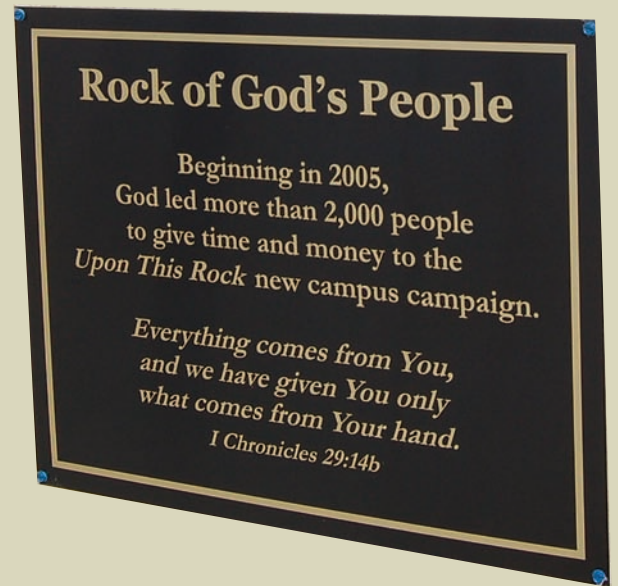
# Upon This Rock... to the Summit!

Can you believe that it will soon be four years since we moved to our new campus at 300 Eagle Lane! In addition, the realization that the planning for this transition began already in the early 1990's illustrates the fact that God's timing is far above our ability to comprehend or imagine. Through school boards, long-range planning teams, and visionary individuals, the reality of these dreams, plans, and earnest endeavors began to take visible shape in 2005. **So, where do we go from here?** As you know, we've been raising funds for this new campus project through our "Upon This Rock" campaign for six years now, and we're getting closer to the end, but we're not quite there yet. If we could summarize our current message into one phrase, it might be something like "We've been at this for six years – let's finish it in seven!" So, here's the plan:

- The New Campus Finance Team has been working diligently in the last six weeks to raise a "challenge fund" to help us retire the remaining obligation of \$800,000 on our campus. The initial push for the "challenge fund" came from within. The Phase I and Phase II Finance Teams, current PCHS Board and Staff, and committed individuals set the bar high by raising \$160,000. Then with the help of various foundations and businesses, we currently have a challenge fund of \$245,000 and are still contacting other sources to raise this amount.
- Now our challenge to you as the constituency is to raise the last \$555,000. To accomplish our goal, we would ask you to consider a cash gift to be paid yet in 2011 or a pledge gift to be paid on or before January 31, 2013. For each \$2.25 that you contribute, another dollar has already been matched from the challenge fund.



As you consider your year-end giving or look into planning your budget for the coming calendar year, we would ask that you prayerfully consider a gift (cash, stock, grain) at this time or a pledge for 2012 as we plan to retire the debt on our new campus.
